Assuming that the robot is controlled by a three-layered controller (Fig. 1a), we agree with Arkin (Arkin, 2008, Arkin et al., 2012) that ethical behaviour should be governed by adding a fourth specialised control layer. This Ethical Layer (Fig. 1b) should act as a governor evaluating behaviour proposed by each of the three other layers before the robot executes it.
